

WILDFIRE RECOVERY JOBS

Jobs Funded by Federal Disaster Grant
Still Available in Sevier County

Are you currently unemployed due to the November 2016 wildfire?

The Tennessee Department of Labor & Workforce Development (TDLWD) continues to recruit workers to fill positions funded by a federal grant to assist in wildfire recovery efforts in the Gatlinburg area.

These positions are open to individuals left without a job following the November 2016 wildfire, regardless of which county they reside. Any unemployed resident of Sevier County may also be eligible for work, as long as they are unemployed at no fault of their own.

There are a variety of positions available, with pay ranging from \$9 to \$22 per hour, and work is expected to last through December 2017. The grant also provides support services to eligible workers including transportation, child care and a clothing allowance.

Individuals may apply Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. at the American Job Center at 1216 Graduate Drive in Sevierville. They must bring a state issued identification card or driver's license and their social security card. Applicants will be required to pass a drug screening and physical before they are hired to work for Sevier County government agencies.
